



**2019 PILGRIMAGE – AUGUST 1-4
NATIONAL SHRINE OF OUR LADY OF GOOD HELP
NATIONAL SHRINE OF ST. JOSEPH**

THURSDAY, AUGUST 1

- 1:00 Pilgrimage Registration Desk Open in Lobby. If you are in need of a ride to the 5:00 Mass please sign up at this time. Otherwise, we will all walk to St. Francis Xavier Cathedral.
- 2:15 All Pilgrimage participants ages 8-18 are invited to participate in the Pilgrimage Liturgical Events. Anyone 8-18 who wishes to serve at liturgies during the Pilgrimage must attend Catechetical Training with Fr. Luke Millette, and Michael Poradek at St. Francis Xavier Cathedral. Those 8-18 who wish to participate in the liturgies/Masses must wear the Pilgrimage uniform. **All parents are encouraged to accompany their children.** Gather in the lobby at 2:00 for the short walk to St. Francis Xavier Cathedral.
- 4:00 Meet in Hyatt Lobby. Walk to St. Francis Xavier Cathedral. If you have preregistered for a ride, you will meet your driver in the lobby.
- 5:00 Pilgrimage Opening Mass. Knights and Dames wear robes/capes with cross. Bishop David L. Ricken is Celebrant. After Communion, the Blessing of all Pilgrims – the sick and healthy. We ask for the Grace to accept the merciful healing and love of Jesus through Mary during our Pilgrimage.
- Immediately following Mass recessional by clergy (Knights and Dames do not process out) The three Presidents will distribute the Pilgrimage Medal to first time Pilgrims in church.
- 7:00 Dinner at Hyatt on Main in Ballroom A, with presentation on History of the National Shrine of Our Lady of Good Help by Bishop Ricken and Fr. John Broussard. Afterwards, Fra' Tom Mulligan will lead us in Evening Prayer.

FRIDAY, AUGUST 2

- 6:30 Breakfast Buffet opens at the Hyatt. Don't forget to bring your breakfast ticket.
- 7:30 Bus 1 is for the Servers and their families, and anyone who needs to arrive a little early. You may board any bus you want, but the bus you choose will be your assigned bus for the rest of the Pilgrimage. **Knights and Dames bring robes/capes.**
- 8:00 Depart for Shrine of Our Lady of Good Help. Rosary during bus ride.
- 8:45 St. Joseph Room for Robing
- 9:00 Mass in the Chapel. Knights and Dames wear robes and process.
- 10:00 Walk the grounds, visit the apparition site, confessions offered throughout the campus. Priests will be in the church confessionals as well as outside on benches at the back of the Shrine. Look for Hospitality (red) team to show you the way.
- 11:30 Board your assigned Bus.
- 12:00 Depart for Riverside Ballroom for lunch.
- 12:30 Lunch. Joined by guests from the VA and retired Priests from Green Bay Diocese.
- 1:45 Board your assigned Bus for Old St. Joseph Church on Campus of St. Norbert College.
- 2:15 Knights and Dames will robe in room off the Narthex. Please be seated in the church. The front rows are reserved for those who wish to receive the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick.

- 2:30 St. Joseph Church. Fr. Joseph Doyle – presentation about St. Joseph.
- 2:50 Anointing of the Sick at St. Joseph Church. All those who wish to receive the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick should sit in the front rows on both sides of the church. Fr. Joseph Doyle is Celebrant.
- 3:30 Adoration Service with Benediction. Confessions available during Adoration.
- 4:00 Time to visit the beautiful campus of St. Norbert College.
- 4:30 Board your assigned Bus.
- 5:00 Depart for Hyatt Hotel.
- 7:00 Dinner at Hyatt in Ballroom A. No need to change clothes. Wear your uniform if you'd like. After dinner, Michael O'Neil – The Miracle Hunter – will give a talk. At close of evening Fra' Tom Mulligan will lead us in Evening Prayer.

SATURDAY, AUGUST 3

- 6:30 Breakfast Buffet opens at the Hyatt. Remember to bring your breakfast ticket.
- 8:00 Board your assigned Bus. We will not need our Robes/Capes today.
- 8:30 Depart for National Shrine of Our Lady of Good Help.
- 9:00 Arrive at Shrine.
- 9:30 Rosary Procession.
- 11:00 Mass of Our Lady of Cana in the Mother of Mercy Hospitality Center. During Mass married couples will renew their commitment to marriage and consecrate their marriages to the Blessed Mother. All spouses sit together.
- 12:30 Catered lunch at Shrine.
- 2:00 Stations of the Cross in Chapel (no robes/capes).
- 3:00 Quiet reflection time/bathroom break.
- 3:30 Adoration and Healing Service in Chapel. Fr. John Broussard, Rector of the Shrine is celebrant.
- 4:30 Free Time at the Shrine.
- 5:00 Sunday Vigil Mass for Sunday travelers in the Mother of Mercy Hospitality Center.
- 5:30 Board your assigned Bus for Hyatt Hotel.
- 6:00 Depart for Hotel.
- 7:30 Closing Dinner at the Hyatt in Ballroom A. Wear whatever you like, but most change and do not wear the uniform.

SUNDAY, AUGUST 4

- 7:00 Breakfast at the Hyatt. Remember to bring your breakfast ticket.
- 9:00 Mass at St. Francis Xavier Cathedral. No robes/capes. There will be a tour of the Cathedral and Museum available after Mass given by Carol who is a docent of St. Francis Xavier Cathedral.
