THURSDAY, AUGUST 4

- 12:00 PM Pilgrimage Registration opens in lobby of the Hyatt. If you need a ride to the 5:00 PM Mass at St. Francis Xavier Cathedral, please register at this time. The Cathedral is an 8-block walk from the Hyatt.
- 12:00 PM Youth Program Meeting in Hyatt Conference room GRAND B. All Pilgrimage Participants ages 8-17 are invited to participate. Parents must accompany their children to this 12:00 PM meeting. A pizza lunch will be served. All children 8-17 who would like to serve at Mass must wear the Pilgrimage uniform.
- 2:00 PM Optional – Presentation on Catholic Healthcare, Dr. Robin Goldsmith, MD, DM, CEO, St Gianna Clinic, in Hyatt Conference room GRAND C.
- 2:30 PM Youth Group break.
- 3:00 PM Youth Group departs for the Cathedral.
- 3:00 PM Optional - Diocesan Museum opens in the basement of the St. Francis Xavier Cathedral for tours. It will close at 4:30pm.
- 4:00 PM Meet in Lobby for walk/ride to Mass at St. Francis Xavier Cathedral. Those who previously requested transportation can depart as cars arrive. Knights and Dames bring robes/capes.
- 4:15 PM Pilgrims walking depart for St. Francis Xavier Cathedral. Umbrellas are available in case of inclement weather.
- 4:30 PM Knights and Dames robe in the Cathedral Center.
- 4:55 PM Assemble in rear of church for procession.
- 5:00 PM Pilgrimage Opening Mass – The Blessed Virgin Mary, Queen of all Creation - Celebrant, The Most Reverend John F. Doerfler, STD, JCL, Bishop of Marquette

After Communion, there will be a blessing for all Pilgrims – the sick and healthy. We ask for the grace to accept the healing love of Jesus through Mary and Joseph during our Pilgrimage.

Immediately following the Mass recessional by clergy (Knights and Dames do not process out), Pilgrimage medals will be distributed to first time Pilgrims in the Cathedral.

- 6:30 PM Cash Bar opens at the Hyatt in Ballroom A.
- 7:00 PM Dinner at the Hyatt in Ballroom A with a cash bar open throughout dinner. Please wear your uniform.
- 8:30 PM Night Prayer (Compline) at dinner tables.

FRIDAY, AUGUST 5

- 6:30 AM Breakfast opens in the Hyatt lobby dining area.
- 7:45 AM Board all buses at the Elm St. entrance of the Hyatt. Bus 1 is for the priests, servers and their families, and anyone who needs to arrive a little early. You may board any bus you want, but the bus you choose will be your assigned bus for the rest of the Pilgrimage. Knights and Dames bring robes/capes.
- 8:00 AM Buses depart for the National Shrine of Our Lady of Good Help. PLEASE NOTE: Cell service is poor at the Shrine. We recommend you join the Shrine's Wi-Fi network: Network ID: Shrine Guest, Password: Hemlock1859 and enable Wi-Fi Calling on your phone.
- 8:45 AM Knights and Dames use Mother of Mercy Hall for robing.
- 9:10 AM Assemble at entrance of Apparition Chapel for procession.
- 9:15 AM Mass in Apparition Chapel- Memorial of the Dedication of the Basilica of Saint Mary Major in Rome – Celebrant, Very Rev. Brian Dellaert, Ch M. Following Mass, Knights and Dames will process out.
- 10:30 AM Confessions are available in Mother of Mercy Hall (please do not seek confession in the Apparition Chapel as that is for the daily pilgrims to the Shrine). Ask members of the Red Hospitality Team to direct you. You may want to visit the Welcome Center to learn about the history of the Shrine or visit the Oratory, the site of the 1859 Apparition.
- 12:00 PM Lunch is held in Mother of Mercy Hall.
- 1:30 PM Optional - A brief history of St. Joseph and the National Shrine of St. Joseph will be presented in Mother of Mercy Hall for those who have never visited the Shrine.
- 2:00 PM Board your bus to the National Shrine of St. Joseph.
- 2:15 PM Buses depart to the National Shrine of St. Joseph.

- 3:00 PM Arrive at the National Shrine of St. Joseph. Feel free to venerate and pray at the Shrine. Confessions will be available in the chapel.
- 3:30 PM Rite of the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick – Celebrant, Fr. Augustine Puchner, O. Praem, Ch M. All those who wish to receive the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick should sit in the front rows on both sides of the main aisle. No robes/capes will be worn.
- 4:45 PM Board your bus to The Marq Supper Club.
- 5:00 PM Buses depart to The Marq Supper Club (3177 French Road, De Pere WI, 54115).
- 5:30 PM Cash Bar commences at The Marq Supper Club.
- 6:00 PM Dinner at The Marq Supper Club with a cash bar throughout dinner. Please wear your uniform.
- 7:00 PM Night Prayer (Compline) at dinner tables.
- 7:30 PM Board your bus to return to the Hyatt.
- 7:45 PM Buses depart for the Hyatt.
- 8:00 PM Youth Group Ice cream and Games social, in Hyatt Conference room GRAND B.

- 6:30 AM Breakfast opens in the Hyatt lobby dining area.
- 8:00 AM Board your bus. Knights and Dames do not need robes/capes this day.
- 8:15 AM Buses depart for the National Shrine of Our Lady of Good Help.
- 9:00 AM Rosary Procession
- 10:30 AM Mass for the Feast of the Transfiguration of the Lord, in Mother of Mercy Hall. Celebrant, Rev. Msgr. Edward Dillon, Ch M. PLEASE NOTE: There will be a 10-minute comfort break between the end of the Mass and beginning of the Eucharistic healing service.
- 11:30 AM Eucharistic Healing Service in Mother of Mercy Hall. Celebrant, Very Rev. Richard “Luke” Millette, Ch M.
- 12:30 PM Lunch is held in Mother of Mercy Hall.
- 2:00 PM Reflection on the theme “I Am the Queen of Heaven” in Mother of Mercy Hall by Very Rev. John W. Girotti, Ch M.
- 2:45 PM Time for personal reflection, visiting the Oratory, or visiting the gift shop. If you desire to make a confession, please seek out one of our priests.

- 4:00 PM Vigil Mass for the Nineteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time, in Mother of Mercy Hall - Celebrant, Rev. Gerald Murray, Ch M.
- 4:45 PM Board your bus to return to the Hyatt.
- 5:00 PM Buses depart for the Hyatt.
- 6:00 PM Open Bar opens at the Hyatt in Ballroom A.
- 6:00 PM Youth Group meeting, in Hyatt Atrium (west area, where breakfast is usually served). Snacks will be served.
- 7:00 PM Closing Dinner at the Hyatt in Ballroom A with an open bar throughout dinner. Wear whatever you like, but most change and do not wear the uniform.
- 8:30 PM Night Prayer (Compline) at dinner tables.

SUNDAY, AUGUST 7

- 7:00 AM Breakfast in the Hyatt lobby dining area.
- 9:00 AM If you did not join the Order for the Vigil Mass on Saturday at the Shrine you may want to join the regularly scheduled Mass at St. Francis Xavier Cathedral. There will be a tour of the Cathedral and the museum available after Mass.
